



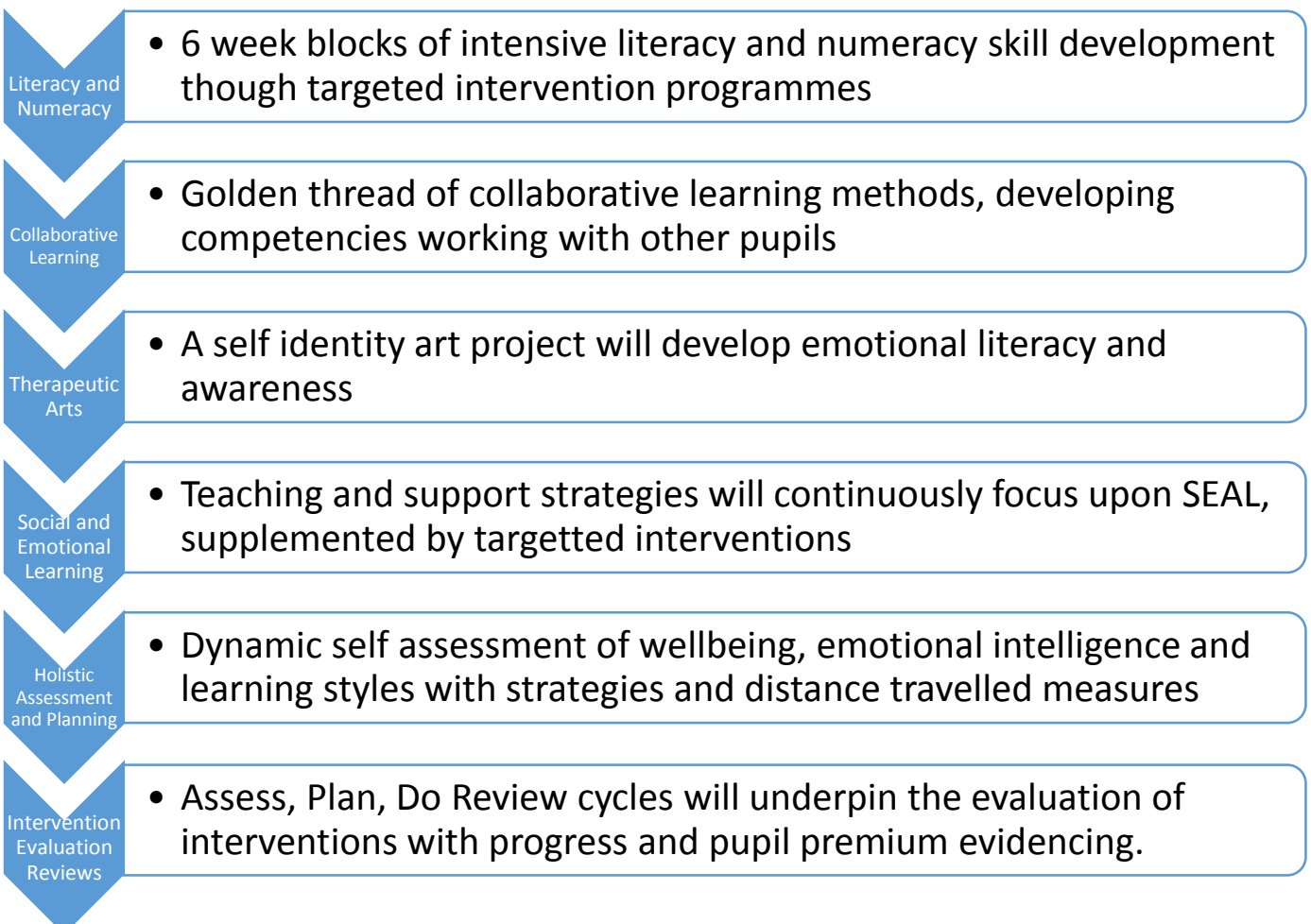
A programme of offsite learning focussing upon holistic assessment of barriers to learning, skill development, emotional development and transition planning

### Programme Aims

To improve the literacy and numeracy skills of pupils through an intensive but low pressure learning environment.

To develop the pupils awareness of their own social and emotional development targets, and personal strategies for improvement.

To effectively transfer progress on the programme back to mainstream to facilitate continued progress



## Manchester Settlement School

We offer alternative education programmes at KS3/4 for schools within travelling distance. We are a registered school, and have achieved a Good Ofsted rating. We employ qualified teachers supported by talented mentors to create a learner centred, holistic learning and intervention programme, including GCSE's at KS4.
